
Boat Mobile Craft Activity!





Instructions

Print pages 1–4 two-sided (2 pages) on 8.5 x 11-inch card stock using a color printer. Cut out the mobile base and the five hanging boat images. Use a hole punch to cut the small circles where indicated. Use colorful ribbon, string, or yarn to attach the boats to your mobile base by looping the strings through the punched holes. Cut your strings at various lengths so your boats will hang at different levels. To hang your mobile, cut a separate piece of string and tape it securely to the center top of your mobile base.
